The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for a Data/Knowledge Sovereignty Fellow.

Data/Knowledge Sovereignty Fellow will be responsible for working under the direction of the Karuk Department of Natural Resources' Data/Knowledge Sovereignty Team to assist with tasks associated with supporting community education around Indigenous data/knowledge sovereignty and supporting the Tribe begin to frame and outline elements of an Indigenous Data/Knowledge Sovereignty Policy. These tasks include, but are not limited to the following:

- Learning about and researching Indigenous data/knowledge sovereignty concepts and policies/protocols currently being used by other Indigenous communities
- Presenting what you are learning with Tribal staff and community
- Convening an Indigenous Data/Knowledge Sovereignty Speaker Series (primarily virtual, but with opportunistic in-person events as well) for Tribal staff and community to include: identifying and reaching out to prospective speakers, scheduling speaking dates, providing introductions and bio as well as guidance for their presentations. We are aiming to have at least 4-7 speakers included as a part of this series.
- Convening an Indigenous Data/Knowledge Sovereignty panel for the Klamath Fire Ecology Symposium (to be held July 1-3, 2024)
- Sharing ideas and input into Indigenous data/knowledge sovereignty policy development
- Providing edits and revisions into draft Indigenous data/knowledge sovereignty policy
- Creating flyers for events as needed
- Convening Tribal staff and community members to provide input as needed

The Data/Knowledge Sovereignty Fellow must have a willingness to work and take direction, flexibility, the ability to work well with others, an interest in learning about Indigenous data/knowledge sovereignty, and the willingness to take initiative in being the point person coordinating the tasks listed above.
