The Karuk Tribe seeks food service proposals for the Reunion BBQ Cook for the 23rd Annual Karuk Tribal Reunion to be held on Saturday, July 13th, 2019 at the Karuk Tribe Administrative Complex, 64236 Second Avenue, Happy Camp, CA.

Food will need to be served buffet style in two lines to aide in the fast flow of guests. Respondents will be responsible for recruiting their own volunteers to help with preparation, serving, and cleaning. The Karuk Tribe's kitchen will be available to bidders for food preparation and cooking for snack and dinner which will be served at the Karuk Tribal multi-purpose room. Respondent must provide their own barbeque. There will be tables and chairs both in the multi-purpose room and an outside tent area for dining.

Proposals shall include all time and materials necessary for shopping, food preparation, and related services for the meals and menus listed below (the menu items are specified and not to be modified). Snack items are to be provided as a courtesy during the day as there will also be food vendors selling items on the premises.

Service also includes providing all paper goods, utensils, condiments, and trash bags, removal of trash and spill clean-up in the serving and eating areas, assistance with setting-up of tables/chairs for serving (to be served in the multi-purpose room), and overall clean-up of the facilities. Respondents must wear hairnets during food preparation and servicing. Any individuals that will help with meal preparation must also wear hairnets and gloves.

Service should be for 600 guests at dinner. Respondents must possess current Food Handler's Certificate.
