The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work required by the U.S. Department Interior's Bureau of Indian Affairs, for the transfer of real property from fee to trust status and the construction of a new medical/dental clinic to be located at 64109 Hillside Road, Happy Camp, CA 96039 - Siskiyou Assessor's Parcel Number# 016-412-200. The project also includes the transfer of additional adjacent APN's 016-412-090, 120,230, and 300 with no planned change in land use.

Task One:

Prepare an Environmental Assessment ("EA") to satisfy the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA") of 1969 (42 U.S.C. §4321 et seq.); the Council on Environmental Quality Guidelines for Implementing NEPA for the placement of approximately 5.87 acres from fee to federal trust status, and the construction of an approximately 10,000 sq. ft. clinic/dental facility.

- A. For the fee to trust action, the EA shall be consistent with Department of Interior's Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") recommended format per BIA NEPA Handbook (59 IAM 3-H).
- B. For the construction, the EA shall be consistent with the U.S. Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") recommended format per 24 CFR 58.36. In addition to the HUD Indian Community Development Block Grant, possible funding for the facility construction may also include the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. It is required that the proposed NEPA EA satisfy these specific funders environmental compliance requirements as well. This task may include a separately formatted HUD EA.

The Karuk Tribe previously completed a HUD formatted EA, and cultural resources study, on the subject parcel for the Family Services Center in April 2017 (construction completed in 2018). Both of these documents will be available.

Responses to this Request for Proposals must include the following:

A statement of qualifications, including number of years working for or (1) performing consultant services for Tribal governments with a description of services provided.

- (2) A proposed approach and rationale for completion of the Scope of Work, including descriptions of <u>similar work previously completed</u> and the results/benefits achieved.
- (3) Timeline for completion of work.
- (4) Itemized bid price for labor and expenses.
- (5) Names and telephone numbers of three clients' references.
