- Can assist even if both parties are native

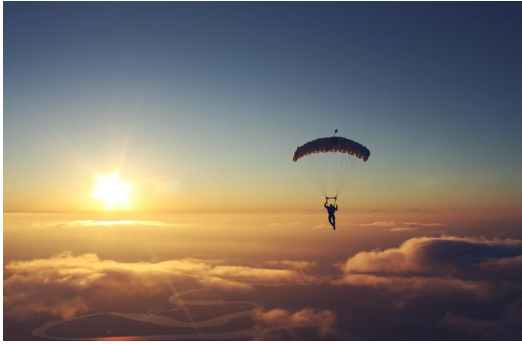
