The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work for the Yreka Karuk Community Garden. The Karuk Tribe is seeking a private contractor garden groundskeeper for the 2025 growing season. The groundskeeper is responsible for the planting and watering of fruit trees and vegetables, weeding, harvesting, tracking production and waste, composting, farm expansion (as approved), cleaning, clearing brush, building planter boxes, installation of irrigation equipment and general maintenance of the garden. The groundskeeper shall also assist in the distribution of produce to Karuk Tribal members in the Yreka community.

The groundskeeper will maintain garden tools, storage facilities, farm stand, irrigation systems and any other Tribal equipment and supplies. Groundskeeper will follow the Yreka Karuk Community Garden Standard Operating Procedures. Invoicing will be required on a bi-weekly basis and will include tracking of production and composting.

The groundskeeper will provide and maintain their own vehicle for use. Any questions, concerns, needs or purchasing will be communicated with Public Works staff efficiently and in a timely manner. The groundskeeper shall provide lists to Public Works for ordering supplies and equipment as needed.

Applicant must:

- be at least 18 years of age
- capable of working in inclement weather
- able to lift over 50lbs
- work efficiently and independently

Contract Details:

- Contract is for 6 hours a day, \$25 per hour, 5 days a week.
- This is an at will contract that can be terminated at any time without cause.
- Contract includes a waiver of liability
- Contractor required to file a 1099c
- This is a private contract. Contractor is not employed by the Karuk Tribe.

Phase One

Prepare and install items for the 2025 growing season. This shall include but is not limited to, weeding, installing irrigation systems, planting seeds and starts, properly labeling the seeds and starts, general landscaping and grounds maintenance.

Phase Two

Groundskeeper will maintain the Yreka Karuk Community Garden throughout the growing season.

Phase Three

Winterization of the Garden and cool weather planting. Secure the water system for the winter months. Planting cover crops, till, mulch as needed.

Phase Four

Prepare, order, and install items for the 2026 growing season.

Responses to this Request for Proposals should include the following:

- 1) A statement of qualifications, including relevant project history.
- A proposed approach and rational for completion of the contract tasks described above, including descriptions of similar work previously completed and the results/benefits achieved.
- 3) A lump sum price, with attached price page.
