The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work for the Sky Line Work Force Housing development in Happy Camp, California, located at APN 016-412-240 on a three-acre parcel. The proposals shall include clearing, grubbing, survey, geotechnical, approaches, site development, and all necessary documentation for installation of all utilities and permitting where required; water main, sewer main, sewer lift station, electrical power, communication, storm drains, fire hydrants, paved roadways, street lights, concrete sidewalks, curb and gutter.

- Utility's will be installed to each lot, including electrical, sewer, water, and communications and inspected by Karuk Tribe
- California State standard for paved roadway as well as ADA compliance for sidewalks.
- All material used in backfill, structural backfill, house pads will undergo monitoring and testing to meet compaction requirements by third party licensed engineer as part of scope of work by the contractor.
- Storm drain installation, inlets as well as storm run-off and leach field built according to plans.
- Environmental awareness and monitoring storm water and pollution and remedy. BMP silt fence, hydro seed were needed, Dust control and track out to be assumed by contractor.
- Tribal monitoring for cultural sensitivity during all excavation a must. Contractor will notify Karuk Tribe 72 hours prior to excavation to ensure tribal monitoring is available.
- Asphalt and Concrete to follow American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO) and American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) at a minimum Federal Specifications (Standard Specifications FP-14).
- All work shall be performed by Contractors licensed in their trade. Materials installed properly according to manufactures specification and all necessary testing to ensure proper operation

• All sub-contractors to be authorized by Karuk Tribe prior to issuing a contract
