The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work required for deleting the program light system currently installed in the Karuk Medical/Dental clinic located at 1519 South Oregon St. Yreka, Ca. The current program light system, throughout the facility, is faulty and we want to bypass the low voltage system in favor of a standard/manual electrical lighting system. All State and Local code must be strictly followed. All applicable permitting and inspections will be the responsibility of the Contractor.

Task One – DEMO

DEMO existing low voltage wiring, switch gear and light fixtures that cannot be salvaged and reused. Mark and safeguard all project materials and debris until it can be properly disposed of by the Contractor at their sole expense. Keep walkways clear at all times. The area will need to be barricaded and clearly marked in a way that does not allow pedestrian traffic to pass through. The work area will be properly secured at the end of the day by the Contractor to the satisfaction of the Owner.

Task Two – Installation

New wiring, switches and light fixtures will be installed in current equipment locations. Wire sizing and type will be adequate for the length of run and current being carried, per State and Local codes. Switches will be standard rocker design and sized appropriately. Light fixtures will be 2'x4' LED troffer style lighting for drop ceilings with a color temperature of 5000K. All equipment finish colors TBD by owner.

Task Three – Ensure proper function/Clean up

The new lighting system will be tested for proper function and to insure program system has be completely deleted. Any damage caused as a result of the DEMO and installation of the wiring or other components will be repaired by the Contractor by this point. All remaining DEMO/Project debris and materials will be hauled off at this time and the area will be left in a condition equal to or better than found.
