The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work from qualified individuals.

Scope of Work

Provision of equine family therapeutic learning groups and/or equestrian facilitated psychotherapy services for clients as an adjunct to traditional outpatient substance use disorder treatment.

Focus of groups to include team building, leadership skills, communication skills and emotional intelligence. The development of these strategies will help improve cooperation, help develop empathy, build confidence, develop/improve communication skills, social relationships and creative problem solving. Facilitator(s) is subject to an investigation of character as required by the Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act. The minimum standards require an investigation that shall include: a check of fingerprint files of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, written inquiries to appropriate local law enforcement agencies. Applicant must not have been found guilty of, or entered a plea of no contender or guilty to, any offense under Federal, State or Tribal law involving crimes of violence; sexual molestation; exploitation; contact or prostitution; crimes against persons; an offense involving a child victim; or a drug felony.
