The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work required for **Graduation Stoles with Karuk Basket Designs** for graduating High School Students & College Graduates Class 2022. Interested individuals who have an expertise in creating & making stoles must have them **complete by March 4<sup>th</sup>**, 2022.

## Task One - Design and Create

Contractor will coordinate with the Education Department Director regarding selection of designs and approval of final product. Seventy-five (75) stoles are to be created for graduating High School Students and College Graduates.

## Task Two - Fabricate Stoles

Contractor is responsible for producing and making stoles for Karuk Graduates by March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

The Karuk Tribe Education Department is requesting 75 Stoles to be made. Stoles must be **60 total inches** in length (30 inches per side, including neck rest area), with a **4-inch minimum in width** not to exceed **5-inches in width**.

OPTIONAL: additional opportunity to provide beaded fringe at the ends of each stole. We request a minimum of four strands per side. In proposal include the total cost of finished product stole with bead work.

## Task Three - Complete and Deliver.

Contractor will coordinate with the Education Director for delivery of stoles to the Karuk Tribe.

### Responses to this Request for Proposals should include the following:

- 1) Contractor will provide documentation of demonstrated experience in creating and fabricating stoles. Including relevant project history, pictures of created stoles OR relevant projects.
- 2) A lump sum price, with attached price page.
- 3) Names and telephone numbers of three references.
