Classes will be held at local schools. **We have one (1) position available.**

Task One

Organize and conduct a weekly Bounce Back talking group at the local schools and Kahtishraam Wellness Center, provide talking groups, and oversee activities within the Bounce Back lesson plans.

- a. Organize materials/supplies required prior to each session.
- b. Ensure the group includes the target population of at least 5 participants (assist with recruitment), with a max of 10. Includes collect sign in sheet and pre-& post surveys for grant requirements.
- c. Promote an emotionally safe setting and structure within which the target population can develop caring relationships and use authentic voices.
- d. Prepare for meetings and become familiar with material and activities.
- e. Provide input and/or create purchase requests for incentives and class supplies.
